Using the principles that she learned and teaches today, she was voted the most popular girl in the school within two years. And she graduated cum laude from Delaware State University in three years despite being an average student in high school.

S. Renee, an image consultant, motivational speaker, columnist and author of *There Is More Inside*, has appeared with her book on Philadelphia's number one television station 6ABC-Philadelphia. She has also appeared on CBS affiliate WPSG-Philadelphia and Comcast Newsmakers.
